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MINUTES OF BCDE UNIVERSITY COORDINATORS MEETING held on 13th July 2022 in Online Mode

The first BCDE University Cooridinators Meeting is conducted in online mode on 13th July 2022 from 3:00 p.m. Prof. M.L,S.Deva Kumar Secretary and CEO BCDE Chaired the session and conducted the meeting. All the BCDE University Coordinators have joined through Webex Meeting and participated in the meeting.

After formal introduction of the participants, Prof. Deva Kumar shared the concept of BCDE, inception, Methodology, Details of Chairman Shri Nedurumalli Ramkumar, Vision, objectives and Roles of various stake holders viz., BCDE University Coorodinators, BCDE College Coordinators, BCDE Student Ambassadors, BCDE Student Members.

He presented the main objectives of BCDE as Creating Awareness to Students of HEI on Community Challenges; Making Youth Socially Conscious and Committed for Development; Creating Awareness to PUBLIC on several Development Factors; Conducting Need Analysis of the Community; Exploring Feasible Solutions through Local Resources; Submitting 'People's expectations' and Action plans to the Govt of AP.

BCDE University Coordinators roles as, to collect and maintain details of BCDE College Coordinators and to establish mode of communication; To formulate communication channel to share information to all BCDE College Coordinators and BCDE Student Ambassadors; To organize capacity building programmes to the BCDE Team Members on various community development criteria; To

Coordinate with District Level Administration, Govt Depts, Village or Ward Secretariats; To prepare / collect templates that can be used as Community Development Activities or Community Service Project., and to submit them to BCDE STATE Secretary & CEO; To provide information about the templates to all the students, who can used them for their CSP; To Collect list of all CSP and consolidate useful outcomes out of them and the submit to the BCDE State Secretary & CEO, for further submission to Govt. of AP.

Various modes of action proposed are

- Conducting Surveys
- Conducting Awareness Programmes
- Preparing Handouts, Posters
- Developing Tools, Techniques, Systems, Methods, APPs to provide solutions to issues of the community
- Developing Short Films, Social Media Shorts, Reels
- Developing Technology Transfer for implementation

Participants Dr.P.Jagapathi from SV Veterinary University, Dr.J.Kathyayani from Sri Padmavathi Mahila University, Dr.B.Satyanarayana from SK University, Mr. Rajasekhar from Rayalaseema University have expressed some of the best practices being implemented at their respective Universities, and also proposed a few suggestions.

During interaction session a few clarifications have been given on the queries of the participants.

Finally a request has been made to all the BCDE University Coordinators to Complete the process of collecting data of BCDE College Coordinators, To instruct the College Coordinators to enroll student volunteers under each college and to select Two BCDE Student Ambassadors (One Boy + One Girl)

from each college, To develop or collect Community Project templates on various Development Criteria and to share with Secretary & CEO, BCDE for uploading on the BCDE website, To plan for BCDE Chairman's visit to University in consultation with respective Vice Chancellors and Registrars.
